Improvement



Paper does not burn in sunlight

Improvement is like sunlight:

- Lot of energy, but dispersed (wasted)
- Small improvements
- Slow progress.

Focused Improvement



Paper burns

Focused improvement concentrates the energy:

- · Little energy, but concentrated and aligned
- Enables significant (large) improvements
- Small time required
- Rapid progress

What is a Kanzen Workshop?

- A Kanzen event is a focused effort used to "make a leap".
- 2 A Kanzen is driven to two imperatives:
 - ➤ Solving Problems
 - ➤ Eliminating waste (Muda)
- A multi-functional team is formed and for a 3-5 day period and they focus on resolving a problem.
- During a Kanzen event, the team will:
 - Identify problems & areas of waste
 - Ask Why?, Why?, Why?, Why?, Why?
 - Figure out ways to fix the problem or eliminate the waste
 - Implement solutions
- 5 Take part. Think about. Make new.
- 6 KANZEN

KANZEN WORKSHOP CHARACTERISTICS

- A short burst of intense activity & effort (3 to 5 days only)
- Biased toward action over analysis
- Focused on improving the value stream and achieving flow
- Driven to resolving a specific problem or achieving a specific goal
- Focused on a specific area or process (either plant or office)
- Managed with daily reviews of progress
- Aimed at achieving specific improvements in a short time
- Managed to resolution/ completion
